Walk Safely to School -

This event is took place on Friday 19 May 2023. All parents and carers were encouraged to take the chance to walk to school. Please have a look at the information from the council.

We had the Liverpool and Green Valley Police Highway Patrol come to the school in the morning to help educate our community about the importance of safe walking to school and good habits on bsy roads.

National Walk Safely to School Day (WSTSD) is on Friday 19 May 2023. Now in its 24th year, the annual campaign encourages all primary school children, their parents and carers to walk safely and regularly to school. The event seeks to promote better health, road safety, public transport and the environment. Australian children are becoming less active. One substantial contributor is the decline in walking and/or taking public transport to school. Children who are regularly physically active are healthier, perform better academically and are less likely to be obese or overweight. Sedentary behaviour can lead to long-term and costly risks of illnesses such as heart disease and diabetes. Walking regularly is the best exercise for your health because you can build it into your daily routine.
